***** COURSE DESCRIPTION *****

This course is designed to meet the needs of health care professionals who respond to cardiac and respiratory emergencies. It teaches:

- The role of the health care provider and the community in the total emergency cardiac care (ECC) system
- The information and techniques needed for adult and pediatric cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and special rescue situations
- The anatomy and physiology of the cardiovascular and respiratory systems
- Risk factors for heart disease and stroke and the concept of prudent heart living
- Signals and actions for survival that victims and health care providers must take to lessen the chance of disability and to prevent sudden death
- Injury prevention in pediatric age group
- Ethical and legal considerations in CPR
