Mount Alverno Center Visitation Fact Sheet

- Mount Alverno Center is planning to open visits indoors though outdoors would be optimal, with supervision.
- Visits are by appointment only and are limited to 1 hour (15 minute screening and 45 minute visit).
- Visitors and residents must comply with Social Distancing and wear face masks at all times. Hand sanitizer should be used before, during and after the visit. All seating will be cleaned between visits.
- There is no physical contact allowed.
- Visitors must be screened for risks, and travel exposures, including temperature checks.
- Mount Alverno Center will not permit any in room visitation.
- No food or drink can be consumed during the visit due to removal of masks.
- There are no restrooms available during your visit.
- Residents are allowed 2 visitors per scheduled appointment.
- Persons under 16 must be accompanied by someone 18 yrs. or older.
- If any visitor fails to adhere to the protocol he, she or they will be prohibited from visiting for the duration of the COVID-19 state declared public health emergency.

Visits will be held on, Wednesdays, Friday, and Saturdays at 10:30am, 1:30pm and 4:00pm by appointment only.
