

## **VISITOR FACTSHEET**

Visitation can occur 24/7 with no limit on the number of visitors or the duration of the visit as long as the visit is not disruptive to our other residents.

All visitors must be screened prior to coming to Scheriver Pavilion. Once the screening is complete, visitors will receive a sticker indicating that they have been screened and will be visiting someone at Schervier Pavilion and may receive a wristband.

Please ensure with a staff member on the unit that your visit can take place in the resident's room or if the visit will need to take place an alternate location.
(Determining factors may include: the number of visitors which may impact the ability to physically distance, the presence of a roommate, etc.) Visitors should limit their movement within the facility.

Please wear a face covering over your mouth & nose at all times. The only exception: If the resident you are visiting is fully vaccinated, you are fully vaccinated and no one else is present during the visit. You can then take your mask off if all vaccinated parties are in agreement. You will have to show proof of your vaccination.

Please maintain physical distance at all times.

The exception: If the resident is fully vaccinated, s/he may choose to have close contact (including touch) with their visitor.

Please practice good hand hygiene utilizing alcohol-based hand rub.

If the resident you are visiting is on precautions, you will need to wear full PPE (personal protective equipment).

## If you test positive for COVID-19 and/or develop signs and symptoms of COVID-19 within 2 days of your visit, please notify the Nursing Supervisor at 845-987-5717.

Those visitors who do not adhere to these guidelines will be asked to leave and may not be permitted to visit in the future.
